

GUIDELINES FOR AFEO DISTINGUISHED HONORARY FELLOW

Distinguished persons of acknowledged eminence are honoured by awarding the Distinguished Honorary Fellowship to them. It is to be awarded to those persons such as Heads of State, Prime Ministers, Deputy Prime Ministers and world-renowned figures who have rendered outstanding services to the engineering profession, the Institution and/or the Nation.

PROCEDURE

Nominations for the award (one nomination per country per year) are to be made annually or whenever the Board of Governors deems fit. They are to be recommended through a member of the Board of Governors.

Each nomination shall be accompanied by a write up of the services and contributions to the profession, the Institution and/or the Nation.

The AFEO Awards Committee shall evaluate each nomination and make recommendations. The final decision shall be made by the Board of Governors. The nominee shall not be contacted until the Board of Governors had agreed on the nomination.

The decision shall be by a vote of the Board of Governors where not less than two thirds of the total members present, must be in favour. Voting is by secret ballot.
